Winemaker Notes:

This three vineyard blend picked all in the same week of September 25th, two of which are coming from high elevation sites. Pine Mountain (2400'), a ridge top above Russian River (1100') and then balanced out by a Chalk Hill site. All components hand sorted, de-stemmed, fermented separately in open top stainless then aged in used French barrels (80%Bordeaux, 20% Burgundy) for 21 months. Unfined and unfiltered.

2017 was a steady growing season which provided optimal fruit ripeness and balance. There was a late heat spike which gave a bit of darker core to the wine. Still made in more of a Loire Valley style the mountain top vineyards added a bit more of a brambly character along with some added structure. A Smith Story Fan Favorite again!
